





Electricians complete extensive tie-in to permanent power for the trailer complex.

When it comes to important milestones in the move planning, the successful move into the eight-trailer complex is a major one! In December 2016 the moves took place successfully.

The complex was powered by two enormous generators until January 17th when electrical contractor Morrow Meadows performed the cut-over to permanent power. This work required physically setting multitudes of 1.5" diameter cords into place, performing tie-ins correctly and achieving final inspection in a two-hour time-frame. The turnover to permanent power went smoothly. Next on the horizon is connection to permanent water for the complex.
